

Two held for killing Punjab social media influencer

TWO MEN have been arrested in connection with the murder of YouTuber Kanchan Kumari, alias Kamal Kaur, Bathinda police Friday said. A third accused, who is also the main conspirator and who claimed 'moral responsibility' of the murder, is absconding, they said.

Kaur's decomposed body was found Wednesday evening in an abandoned car in the parking area of Adesh University in Bathinda, three days after she left her house to attend a promotional event, but later went missing.

Senior SP Amneet Kondal identified the arrested accused as

Jaspreet Singh (32) of Mehron village in Moga and Nimratjit Singh (21) of Patti in Tarn Taran. Amritpal Singh Mehron, also from Mehron village, and a self-styled Sikh radical leader, is absconding, the SSP said.

"A SUV used in the crime has been recovered. Amritpal and Nimratjit have two and one FIRs pending against them, respectively, registered at Amritsar and Dhanaula police stations," SSP told the media.

During the preliminary probe, the arrested men said they killed her for uploading "immoral and vulgar content that hurt the community's sentiments". Sources said the accused also wanted her to remove the surname 'Kaur' from her social media handles.

According to the police, Kaur's mother, Girja Devi, informed them that on the night of June 7, Amritpal visited their home in Ludhiana on the pretext of a business meeting and invited Kaur to travel to Bathinda for a paid promotional event. Amritpal allegedly returned on June 8, but Kaur refused. On June 9, Girja Devi told the police, Jaspreet and Nimratjit came to their home, after which Kaur left with them. Girja Devi told the police that after 11 pm on June 9, she lost all contact with her daughter. According to the police, at around 1 am on June 10, Jaspreet and Nimratjit allegedly drove Kaur to a deserted location where they strangled her.

In HC, Karnataka indicates RCB compensation for stampede victims inadequate

THE KARNATAKA government, which has accused the privately owned Royal Challengers Bengaluru (RCB) of complicity in the deaths of 11 people following a stampede at the M Chinnaswamy stadium on June 4, has questioned the compensation given to families of the victims by the cricket club. The stampede occurred during a celebration of RCB's June 3 victory in the IPL finals.

"These people make ₹450 crore a year, and we have to clean their dirty linen. They are giving a pittance of ₹10 lakh to the victims. Look at their statements, when 11 people have died, they are giving ₹10 lakh. Their valuation is ₹1,000 crore, and this year's profit is ₹450 crore, and all of them have flown away and are least bothered," state Advocate General K M Shashikiran Shetty told the Karnataka High Court during arguments of petitions filed by RCB officials and the event management firm this week.

"They have a lot of urgency for their petitions to be heard in court. They are least bothered about visiting the families or doing anything. They are saying they will open an account for the care of these people, but they are not ready to pay," he argued.

"There is no ex gratia, they have announced they will give ₹10 lakh—take it or leave it. The state has announced ₹25 lakh," Shetty said.

Accused in Raja Raghuvanshi murder case had rented flat in Indore after crime

Indore: A property management businessman in Indore on Friday claimed that one of the accused in the sensational Raja Raghuvanshi murder case had rented a flat from him here a week after the killing.

A probe zeroed in on his wife Sonam, who was held from Ghazipur in Uttar Pradesh, and her alleged aides Raj Kushwaha, Vishal Chauhan, Anand Kurmi and Akash Rajput.

"Chauhan met me on May 30 and rented a flat in Dewas Naka for ₹17,000 per month. He signed a contract and also gave security deposit of ₹34,000. I handed over the keys to him but I am not sure he or any of his companions came there," Shilom James, a property management firm owner. PTI
