

90% of Doctor Posts Filled in Tribal Areas, Remaining Vacancies to be Addressed Soon

625-BED MEDICAL COLLEGE AT MARKAPURAM UNDER PPP MODEL: MINISTER SATYAKUMAR YADAV

Amaravati: Health Minister Satyakumar Yadav announced that the state government has prioritized the filling of doctor posts in hospitals located in tribal regions. Speaking during the Question Hour in the Legislative Assembly on Tuesday, the minister said the government is taking immediate steps to address shortages caused by retirements and resignations.

“Walk-in interviews are being conducted to ensure timely recruitment, along with promotions wherever necessary. Since the coalition government assumed office, 306 Civil Assistant Surgeon posts were sanctioned across 153 PHCs in tribal areas. Of these, 138 posts were vacant, and in the past five months, 131 (90%) have been filled. The remaining 31 vacancies (10%) will also be addressed soon,” he said.

Highlighting developments in Prakasam district, the minister revealed that the coalition government has decided to establish a 625-bed medical college at Markapuram under the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model. He said the previ-



ous government's decisions had created confusion, leading to shortages of doctors and infrastructure. “Only Rs.47 crore was spent on construction earlier, which was insufficient for the needs of a teaching hospital,” he added. Nearly 250 in-service doctors currently pursuing postgraduate studies are expected to return by November and will be assigned to hospitals where their services are most required. Special attention will also be given to improving facilities in hospitals at Kanigiri, Kovvur,

and Buchireddypalem. The minister further noted that under the STEMI program for heart attack patients, specialist doctors are administering free injections worth Rs.45,000, saving nearly 4,000 lives so far. However, he clarified that implementing this system at the PHC level remains challenging due to the absence of specialist doctors in those centers. Thanks to the coalition government's measures, maternal mortality has dropped from 38.8% to 30%, Minister Yadav informed the Assembly.

Debate in Council on False Cases Filed Between 2019-24

MAJORITY OF CASES TARGETED POLITICAL LEADERS, MEDIA, AND AMARAVATI PROTESTERS: HOME MINISTER ANITA

Amaravati, September 23: The Legislative Council on Monday witnessed a heated discussion on false and unlawful cases registered during the previous government's tenure. Responding to a question raised by Konidela Nagababu, State Home Minister Vangalapudi Anita made key remarks, alleging that the YSR Congress government had slapped thousands of cases against political leaders, media representatives, social media users, and Amaravati farmers who fought for the capital cause.

Anita recalled that even she had faced an SC/ST Atrocities case and had to appear before the Kadapa court. She asserted that the present coalition government would not continue the “dark culture” of issuing arbitrary GOs followed by the previous regime. All cases, she said, are being reviewed as per law and steps are underway to resolve them.



The Minister further revealed that out of the cases registered against teachers during the protests demanding the cancellation of the Contributory Pension Scheme (CPS), 80% had already been withdrawn and action was ongoing to clear the remaining.

Anita disclosed that between 2019 and 2024, a total of 3,116 false cases were filed under the YSRCP government. She criticized that many cases were booked simply because people questioned the government, posted or forwarded opinions on social media. She particularly

highlighted that hundreds of cases were registered against Amaravati farmers during their capital movement agitation. “Some cases are under investigation, some are pending trial, and others are under judicial consideration,” she said.

The Home Minister added that Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu would soon conduct a review on the matter and announce the next course of action. A joint meeting with the police and law departments will be held to decide on closure of cases. Responding to reports in Sakshi newspaper that 94% of NDA alliance leaders are facing cases, Anita retorted: “Let there be no confusion. None of our leaders have cases like cockfight, axe attacks, or personal cases filed in the name of mother or sister. These are purely political cases. They were booked only because we questioned the wrong policies of the previous government.”

Vice President Radhakrishnan's Visit Today.



Vijayawada: Ahead of Vice President Radhakrishnan's visit to Vijayawada on the 24th of this month to participate in the Vijayawada Utsav, MP Kesineni Sivanath personally inspected the arrangements at the main venue, Punnami Ghat, on Tuesday. On this occasion, MP Sivanath conducted a review meeting with officials from the police, revenue, tourism, and municipal departments and issued several instructions. He suggested creating dedicated routes to ensure that guests and devotees can reach the ghat without any inconvenience. With the Vice President's visit, this festival will gain national-level recognition. That is why all departments must work in coordination to ensure its grand success.”

Prof. N. Subba Rao Among World's Top 2% Scientists for Sixth Year in a Row

Hyderabad: Prof. N. Subba Rao, former Head of Geology at Andhra University and currently based in Hyderabad, has once again been featured in the prestigious Stanford-Elsevier World's Top 2% Scientists List for 2025, released on September 19. Ranked 3,105 out of 100,000 scientists worldwide, this accolade marks his sixth consecutive year (2020-2025) in the elite global rankings.

Renowned for his pioneering research on groundwater quality, health risk assessment, and environmental sciences, Prof. Subba Rao has authored 135 research papers, including 73 national and 62 international publications. His cumulative impact factor stands at 243, reflecting his far-reaching influence in the scientific community. Over his career, he has received several distinctions, such as the Government of India's National Mineral Award (2009), the Andhra Pradesh State Scientist Award (2009), and the State Best Teacher Award (2014), in recognition of his significant contributions to science and education. Prof. Subba Rao's continued presence on the global list highlights his dedication to research excellence and underscores the growing reputation of Indian scientists in international academia.

Rs. 5,500 Crore Power Projects to Resolve Electricity Issues

Amaravati, Sept 23: To meet the growing electricity demand from households, industries, and agriculture, the state government has launched power infrastructure development works worth Rs.5,500 crore across 68 locations under the jurisdiction of Transco, announced Energy Minister Gottipati Ravikumar in the Legislative Council on Tuesday.

Responding to questions raised by MLCs Beeda Ravichandra Yadav, Perabattula Rajasekhara, and BT Nayudu, the minister said the upcoming projects will help reduce network overload and low-voltage problems. He noted that electricity consumption in the state



is increasing by 6-8% annually, necessitating new sub-station constructions in 14 strategic locations to cater to future demand. Currently, Andhra

Pradesh has 18 sub-stations of 400 kV, 113 sub-stations of 220 kV, and 244 sub-stations of 132 kV, the minister detailed. He credited the coalition government's initiatives

for enabling the state to meet peak power demand effectively. He also highlighted the Integrated Clean Energy Policy and new industrial policies, which are attracting large-scale investments and MoUs from industries, thereby increasing the need for reliable power supply.

To address industrial power needs, the IT, Industries, and Energy departments are working in close coordination, he said.
