Lanka Dinakar Hails GST Reforms: Benefits to Reach Common People

Vijayawada: A national seminar on the benefits of the Central Government's GST reforms was held in Vijayawada, with Lanka Dinakar, Chairman of the Twenty-Point Programme Implementation Committee, attending as the chief guest. The event was also graced by GST Joint Commissioners Prashanth and Kalpana, Andhra Pradesh Chamber of Commerce Chairman Potluri Bhaskar Rao, AP Star Hotels Owners Association President Swami Naidu, and convener Kakani Tarun.

Speaking at the session, Dinakar said that the present theme “Atmanirbhar Next Generation GST Reforms” was closely aligned with Prime Minister Narendra Modi’s vision of a “Viksit Bharat.” He emphasized that GST officials, the Consumer Commission, and trade associations must ensure that the benefits of reduced tax rates truly reach the people through fair pricing and quality services. He recalled that at the 56th GST Council meeting, held on September 22, 2025, the govern-



ment restructured GST slabs from four categories (5%, 12%, 18%, and 28%) to just two (5% and 18%). He thanked PM Modi and Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman for this "historic reform" and credited Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu for being the first CM in India to pass a positive resolution supporting GST reforms in the Assembly. Dinakar noted that the reforms would significantly reduce the

cost of essential goods and services — including food, medicines, insurance, schoolbooks, agricultural tools, and cement — while boosting the purchasing power of nearly 90% of Indian households. He said this was a “double celebration” for citizens ahead of Dussehra and Diwali.

“The real spirit of GST reforms is to make trade simpler while directly benefiting common people with affordable goods and services. Dinakar stated, adding that awareness campaigns would be conducted through chartered accountants, trade chambers, and voluntary organizations to ensure people understand and enjoy the benefits. He also dismissed opposition criticism, asserting that GST reforms had reduced taxes compared to the pre-2017 regime and helped strengthen India's economy, funding welfare schemes, infrastructure, free food for 80 crore citizens, housing projects, highways, and rail development. “GST is not about burdening the people, but about empowering them,” Dinakar concluded.

Ex-Minister Adi Narayana Reddy Slams CI Shankarayya Over Legal Notice Controversy



Amaravati: Former minister Adi Narayana Reddy came down heavily on CI Shankarayya for issuing legal notices, alleging that his conduct has damaged the reputation of the Andhra Pradesh Police. “AP Police enjoy a great deal of respect, but Shankarayya’s actions have tarnished that image. Instead of upholding the law, he is siding with the accused and even demanding an apology from the Chief Minister,” Reddy said. Accusing the CI of blackmail, he remarked, “If Shankarayya really valued his own honor, he wouldn’t stoop to such tactics. For the sake of a posting, he is indulging in blackmail and has brought disgrace to the police force. The DGP must take immediate action against him.” Reddy further questioned, “How can a CI dare to serve notices on a Chief Minister? This is a grave mistake, and any punishment would be less for such an act.”

Touching upon past controversies, he recalled the murder of Y.S. Vivekananda Reddy: "Initially, it was claimed to be a heart attack, but later I was falsely accused of being behind the murder along with Chandrababu Naidu. That incident played a key role in Y.S. Jagan's rise to power. Later, the truth came out and even YSR family members realized the actual facts." The ex-minister also hinted at political forces backing Shankarayya, saying, "A CI on his own cannot dare to issue notices to a person of Chief Minister's stature. There are senior YSRCP leaders working behind the scenes. I will raise this issue in the Assembly."

Though his life ended tragically in 1968 at Mughalsarai Junction, his philosophy endures as the guiding light of nationalist politics.
