

Not attack on Cong, says Tharoor, clarifies remark

AMID ROW over his remarks made on Friday that “established parties will cease to be relevant unless they can listen to new voices” and questioning if “our finger was missing from the pulse of Gen Z”, Congress MP Shashi Tharoor on Saturday said that his statements were distorted as an attack on his party.

At an event celebrating the 15th anniversary of India's International Movement to Unite Nations in Mumbai Friday, Tharoor was asked why the Congress was not being able to mobilise students the way the BJP did at Jantar Mantar over alleged exam irregularities.

“I am very conscious of what you have to say... All the Opposition parties have to be conscious of the fact that we didn't provide a route into our parties for the kinds of people who were at Jantar Mantar. And to my mind that is actually something we really need to examine. How do young people get into established parties? Where there are hierarchies, establishments, dynastic considerations, political networks. How does a young person come in... Can they actually be the people who make a difference?” he

had said.

“I think we really need to wake up and smell the coffee. Let not our epitaph be that we were bypassed or became irrelevant because we failed to listen. The established parties will cease to be relevant unless they can listen to the new voices,” he said.

“We should have started hearing them already. Interestingly enough the issues taken up by the BJP and Jantar Mantar protesters had been taken up by us earlier. We had a Chhatron ki Goonj thing where (Leader of the Opposition) Rahul Gandhi was addressing students about paper leaks,” Tharoor had said.

Asked about ‘Chhatron ki

Goonj’ not resonating with youth like C.JP’s call, he had said: “Correct. And that’s why we need to ask ourselves, what did we fail to do? Did we fail to listen? Did we fail to tap into the old cliché of having our finger on the pulse of the people? Was our finger missing from the pulse of Gen Z?”

As his statements started doing the rounds on social media, Tharoor in a post on X Saturday said: “It takes a particular combination of incompetence and malice for some media to interpret my conversation with Rishabh Shah as an attack on my own party or its leadership.”

“Here is the entire video, uncut and unexpurgated, in full, of the conversation. Watch it and judge for yourself, as clearly none of the journalists distorting it have done,” he added. Senior Congress leaders declined to comment on Tharoor’s remarks but quoted his statement on X Saturday.

During Friday’s programme, Tharoor also spoke about July 20 police action on protesters in Delhi.

“The whole thing was very badly handled. And as you know the result worked out in students’ favour and public opinion was so outraged... It became inevitable that the government would have to bend,” he said.

2024 poll setback to Gen Z protests: RSS chief nudges BJP into course correction

RSS CHIEF Mohan Bhagwat's observation that the BJP-led government erred in delaying engagement with protesting youths at Jantar Mantar is being seen in Sangh Parivar circles as more than a comment on the current student agitation over the exam paper leaks. In the Sangh ecosystem, this actually fits a familiar pattern — the RSS publicly signalling its discomfort with BJP dispensation's handling of certain politically sensitive issues, while stopping short of any direct confrontation.

At a youth event in Mumbai Thursday, Bhagwat said, “*Kami to rahi hai*” (there were shortcomings) when asked whether government had delayed in initiating dialogue with youth protesters at Jantar Mantar. He argued that protest is a legitimate form of democratic dialogue, cautioned against branding young protesters as anti-national, and stressed that concerns over India's education system were genuine and required engagement rather than dismissal.

“When something that should not happen, happens, then it is evident some mistake has been committed. *Kami to rahi hai*. It should have been done. We should also see if Gen Z is protesting, it is not protesting because it is opposed to us. It is protesting because it is facing some problem. The solution to that problem must be found,”

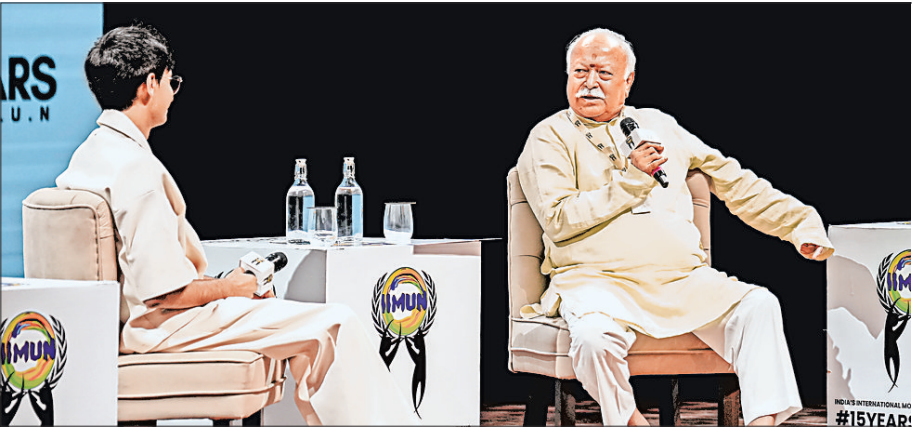
the RSS chief said.

Those familiar with the RSS-BJP relationship say Bhagwat's intervention is best understood in the context of Sangh's long-standing role as ideological mentor that periodically urges its political arm towards course correction. Unlike the Atal Bihari Vajpayee-era Sangh, the Mohan Bhagwat-led RSS rarely takes on BJP government directly. Instead, its interventions typically acknowledge the government's broad direction while identifying deficiencies in implementation, communication or strategy.

That approach was evident during the farmers' agitation in 2020-21 against three now-repealed farm laws, which had marked the last time the Narendra Modi government buckled under a movement's pressure. As protests continued, the government showed resistance in finding a resolution, with the deadlock persisting for months.

In January 2021, then RSS general secretary Bhaiyyaji Joshi openly underlined the need for a dialogue. “It is important to find that point where the two sides can agree and the agitation can end. Any agitation running for long is not beneficial... A middle ground must be found and both sides must work to find a solution,” he had then told *The Indian Express* in an interview.

10 months later, PM Modi announced the repeal of three laws.

After 2024 polls

The 2024 LS elections saw BJP fall short of a majority with its tally dropping from 303 to 240 seats, marking the first time in a decade the party had to rely on its NDA allies to form a government. Days after poll results, Bhagwat said, “A true sevak operates within decorum... he does not get attached, is not arrogant that this has been done by me. Only he can be called a sevak.”

Although he did not mention BJP, the RSS Sarsangchalak's remarks were widely read as a message to its leadership after the party's setback. Its timing amplified such an interpretation. It came soon after then BJP chief J P Nadda suggested in an interview with *The Indian Express* BJP had become organisationally self-sufficient and no longer depended on the RSS in the way it once had.

Bhagwat's comments were

thus seen not merely as a moral observation but also as a reminder that electoral strength had not altered the ideological hierarchy within the Sangh Parivar.

LGBTQ rights

Bhagwat has also, at times, steered broader conservative discourse in directions different from BJP's stances.

In 2013, senior BJP leader Rajnath Singh had opposed decriminalising homosexuality, describing it as “unnatural”.

A decade later, Bhagwat articulated a markedly different position. In January 2023, he argued that homosexuality was a biological reality, rooted his argument in Indian civilisational traditions, and said the LGBTQ deserved dignity and their own private space in society.

Drawing upon the story of Jarasandha's generals Hans and Dimbhaka, Bhagwat suggested that people with same-sex orientation had always existed in India and that society should accommodate them rather than ostracise them. “RSS wants them to have their own private space and to feel that they, too, are a part of society,” he said.

Shifting dynamics

These interventions underline the evolving nature of the RSS-BJP ties during the tenure of the Modi government.

Since 2014, BJP has expanded dramatically, becoming electorally dominant and institutionally stronger than at any point in its history. BJP central leadership exercises far greater autonomy now than earlier, reducing their day-to-day organisational dependence on RSS.

At the same time, RSS has sought to preserve its role as the Parivar's ideological fountainhead rather than just a political manager. Instead of intervening in routine governance matters, it reserves public comments for occasions when it believes that the political leadership might be drifting away from their organisational ethos or losing touch with social sentiments.

That explains why Bhagwat's latest remarks have attracted wide attention as he has sought to again position RSS as BJP's moral compass. As one senior RSS functionary put it, “BJP has come from RSS and not the other way round. Before BJP, there was another party spawned by RSS. What Bhagwat ji says is in the role of a guardian.”
